**LB 753 Opportunity Scholarship State 2024 Tax Credit Deadline Approaching:** LB 753 is Nebraska's first school choice legislation and provides scholarships to qualifying students enrolling at Deshler Lutheran School. This bill allows Nebraska tax payers (individuals, estates, LLC's, foundations) the choice to designate up to 50% of their Nebraska state tax liability towards Opportunity Scholarship which provide educational freedom to qualifying families desiring to attend a Christian school. There is still time for you to *make a no-cost-to-you contribution* to the Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska, designating DLS as the recipient of your funding, & receiving a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for the 2024 tax year, which can be rolled over for the next five years if unused. Thank you for everyone who has already done this! DLS will receive \$14,800 in opportunity scholarship funds shortly because of you! What a tremendous blessing to our families & ministry! You can choose to support DLS & school-choice legislation by completing your paperwork by Oct. 21 and getting your payment to Opportunity Scholarships of Nebraska by Oct. 30. The process is simple. **DLS Health Screening:** DLS School Nurse Karen Schardt will be conducting health screening for all students on Oct. 1-2. Screening includes vision testing (bring your glasses), hearing testing, dental hygiene, height & weight measurements. Parents will be informed of any potential health concerns. We are required to inform you that parents do have the option to opt out of the school health screen. Please turn in a written notice (signed & dated) to DLS if you are interested in opting your child out of school health screening. Unless written notification is received, all students will be screened.
