DLS, and all the schools in ESU Region 5, will finish the 19-20 school year with remote learning. The last day of school will remain May 15th as originally scheduled.

“DLS Drive-Through” Directions:

DLS staff will deliver supplies to parents in a “drive-through” fashion. Vehicles will pull-up in the same manner as morning drop-off, vehicles facing south on sixth street in front of the east entrance. Your family’s books/supplies will be delivered to your car by DLS staff. The drive-up line should start at the main entrance doors on sixth street (vehicles pointing south only) and, if necessary, curve around to the north side of the school building on Hebron Avenue(vehicles heading east).

In an effort to honor the 10 and under mass gathering guideline, entry into the building will be limited. Please inform your classroom teacher, in advance if possible (or during pick-up), of any additional items that your child may need from their locker or desk. Please do not come in the building during pick-up without authorization. Thank you in advance for your understanding and assistance.

Each classroom teacher will be the point of contact regarding assignments and questions that students may have. Adjustments will be made as necessary and as we learn on the go.
